

ABT Membership Registration Agreement

Welcome

Welcome to register as a member of ABT (AI-powered Bioinformatics & Writing Platform). Please read this Agreement carefully before registering. By completing registration, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agreed to comply with the following terms.

I. Membership Account

Appendix: Membership Referral Rules

I. Member Referral Code

36. Upon successful membership registration, the system will automatically generate a Member Referral Code.
